# Hennepin County Adult Mental Health Local Advisory Council

## 2025-2027 Unmet Needs Recommendations

### **1. Improve awareness of existing adult mental health options**

- Utilize peer support and peer navigation for services.
- Centralized website for information inclusive of different demographics.
- Improve visibility of mental health urgent care models like 1800 Chicago, Empath units in hospitals, and short term supports.

### **2. Strengthen strategies to avoid emergency department usage**

- Timely response times and less police involvement for behavioral health crisis response interventions.
- Increase awareness of existing hot lines (e.g., 988, Cope, etc.).
- Extend mental health urgent care sites outside of Minneapolis (e.g., expansion of 1800 Chicago to broader areas of the county).
- Expand person-centered response models (e.g., countywide Smart 911 integration).

### **3. Advance coordination across multiple system partners**

- Explore and promote community-based cohort care model to intervene as groups to service encampments before closure.
- Consistently discharge people to a place where they can maintain their wellbeing.
- Support and expand mental health trained navigators who can make connections for people seeking supports and services.

### **4. Ensure a care model that supports intervention, treatment, and recovery for people with co-occurring conditions...mental health and substance use**

- Establish parity across all mental health and addiction services.
- Center a community integration model that supports individual's unique needs including co-occurring conditions.
- Involve caregivers in care models of those seeking treatment.
