

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Hennepin County Board of Commissioners will hold a public hearing before its County Administration, Operations and Budget Committee at 1:30 pm, or as soon as practicable thereafter, on Tuesday, April 21, 2026. The purpose of the hearing is to consider the proposal to issue up to \$275,000,000 in aggregate principal amount of general obligation bonds of the county for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects that are included in the county's 2026-2030 Capital Improvement Program pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 373.40, subdivision 2(b).

Interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing by telephone conference or in person by using the following instructions and all such persons shall be given an opportunity to express their views with respect to the proposal to issue the bonds to finance the projects.
