SOUTH LOOP DISTRICT PLAN 2025 UPDATE

WHAT IS THE SOUTH LOOP DISTRICT PLAN AND WHY IS IT BEING UPDATED?

Originally adopted in 2012, the South Loop District Plan (SLDP) laid out an ambitious vision for the area: to transform the District "from a dispersed, suburban commercial area into a walkable urban neighborhood that attracts residents, office tenants, hotel guests, and shoppers by virtue of its unique character and assets." To achieve this vision, the SLDP identified strategic public investments that were to set the stage for private investment in the South Loop and nurture its growth.



Because of the 13 years that have passed since its adoption, the City of Bloomington is embarking on an update to this foundational document, taking stock of the District's development and reviewing the consistency of that development with the vision and goals expressed in the SLDP. This effort accounts for the many significant changes, both within and outside of Bloomington, that have shaped the district and will continue to influence its growth. It also evaluates the SLDP's implementation plan to account for accomplishments and reconsider initiatives that no longer align with the current policies and plans of Bloomington.
