Subject: TIF District – Plymouth

Public Hearing: Tuesday, June 11, 2024 7:00PM

Proposal:

The City of Plymouth is proposing the creation of a redevelopment tax increment financing district, with a maximum life of 26 years.

The site of the proposed TIF district consists of a five parcels of land and adjacent right-of-ways, East of Interstate 494 and North of Chankahda Trail (see attached map).


Approximately \$87.3 million of increment and interest is projected over the life of the district.

Increments collected from the TIF District will enable the City to facilitate construction of a multiple-phase redevelopment on the former Prudential Site including Approximately 800 apartments, 60,000 sq/ft office, 60,000 sq/ft grocery store, 31,000 sq/ft retail, 200,000 sq/ft industrial and significant improvements to Chankahda Trail, formerly known as Hennepin County Road 47. The City has designated Roers and Scannell Properties as the developers but has not entered into a development agreement. Development is anticipated to begin in 2024.
